Compose your own melody or song using 'instruments' you can find around your house! This could be a pan and spoon, cheese grater etc. the possibilities are endless. Please video this and attach it to the classroom or email.	Have a go at creating a meal for either a carnivore, herbivore and omnivore. Include a recipe on how this was made.
